

NOTICE TO CONTRIBUTORS

As a result of a recent revision of the taxonomy of mosquitoes in the genus *Aedes* by Reinert (2000, New classification of the composite genus *Aedes* [Diptera: Culicidae: Aedini], elevation of subgenus *Ochlerotatus* to generic rank, reclassification of the other subgenera, and notes of certain subgenera and species. *J Am Mosq Control Assoc* 16:175–188), it will be necessary to change the generic assignment of a number of species from *Aedes* to *Ochlerotatus*. Species affected include a number of common and well-known species such as *Ochlerotatus caspius* (formerly *Aedes caspius*). Of North American species formerly in *Aedes*, only *Ae. aegypti*, *Ae. albopictus*, *Ae. cinereus*, *Ae. hemiteles*, and *Ae. vexans* will remain in the genus *Aedes*. As a matter of editorial policy, we have accepted this change in generic assignment for articles to be published in the *Journal of the American Mosquito Control Association*. As an aid to authors preparing manuscripts, we have prepared a list of the subgenera that are now included in each of the 2 genera. We have also prepared a list of common species that are affected.
