Dear Mr. Watson:

I want to thank you for the packet of Ilex, which I know is at the Garden, though I have not been out to get it yet. I am very glad, too, of the ripe fruit of the Mexican Polygala, enclosed in your letter.

Dr. Engelmann kept Agave Binglei in a distinct species cover from A. deserti, otherwise I have no evidence further than his labels, which state about what Mr. Bingle mentions. The divisions of the perianth are narrower than in A. deserti, otherwise, in a rather superficial examination, I see little difference.
