My Dear Mr Parry

Forward me here your letter
of April 29. I may save
a little time to answer it
once. I am here by appointment
to meet some RR officials
make my report and then
return home. Probably via
St Louis.

I am not personally disappointed
in the step that Torrey's Constabulary
has taken. Especially as it
seems to be a convenience to
the family. I guess Le Roy's
appointment is temporary and he
can keep things from spoiling

till such time as the Trustees
are prepared to honor appreciating
in Torrey's life work. In the
mean time I have plenty to
do and look after. and as you

I suppose I shall have but
little over a week at Dawson
before starting west again

I sent you a small parcel
of roots by mail from Concordia.
I fear they may not reach
you in good condition. The
Anemone Decapetala is a charming
plant. with two distinct varieties
white & blue. I see I found
a bulb which may help it to
keep alive

I enclosed in a newspaper to
Watson, a very neat Alliaceae
plant quite new to me. I
suppose it will have to pass as
an Allium. but the stamens are
enclosed by a row of hyaline
scales. the whole plant is a
pretty hyacinth clone. If a ~~true~~
Allium & new sp. a good sp
name would be A. coronatum.
I shall show specimen to
Engelmann. perhaps he can
name it for me. I only
found it in one locality while
on a long tedious horseback
trip to a desolate salt district
but I have enough specimens to
supply the principal herbaria
Mr P. writes that Backhaus
has written me again giving
a list of desiderata. If I
am able to do anything for
him this fall at Empire city
