

Society Hill, S. C. Jan: 14th 1856.

My Dear Sir,

I would not trouble you just yet, but I want to get that Fungus figure out of mind, & the Fungus plate off from my writing desk. Nevertheless, do not hurry yourself to answer, but take a comfortable leisure moment.

The Plate is from "Ann. des Scien. nat. 4^e Serie", - "Bot. Tom. 1. pl. II." It contains figures of seven Fungi (2 spp. of Cantharellus, 2 of Clavariaceus, & 2 of Agaricus) but the 7th is not named at the bottom of the plate. The name of this 7, 7^a, 7^b, is what I want to ascertain. I can not be more explicit than this, having exhausted all the data.

Having now learned from you how discriminating your Academy is in the election of Fellows, I do not know that I have expressed my acknowledgements with sufficient vigor. But it is too late to remedy the omission, though I should be sorry to have it thought that I depreciated an intended honor. I suppose it is the duty of those thus distinguished to reflect back as much renown as they can, & I will therefore see if I can do the Academy any credit. I reckon I can keep pace with Short; but I can hardly

caring so much now for these vulgar subjects.
