sets, one for Mr. Wright, the other for
a gentleman who promised to send *Wulffia*
plants, which he had collected in a
Jugovian capacity: Do you know any
thing of him and the value of his col-
lections?

My dear Dr. M. Gray,

The new tuba plants are safe in my
hands: I had been very anxious whether
they had not been injured, the German
climate by which they came having had
a passage of unprepared storage weather;
but I am glad to say, that they are
as good as ever. As you have to myself
to fix the price, I shall make the
same calculation as with regard to the
last collection, but less doubtful with
regard to the money-market it
is better for Mr. Wright to pay American
dollars or Prussian Thalers, and I expect
only your answer to pay Mr. H. H. in
at Hamburg.

I hope to give you a welcome
news in telling you, that Dr. Hooker
has had the great liberality of presenting
me with the whole stock of duplicates
of the Wulffian Flora, so that I
can now offer you the first number
of the collections to be formed for editi-
on. Just as I await what the

specimens myself, I am rather afraid to begin with it: there are about twenty large bunches. As soon as I have seen him to do it, I may send them and ask whether it is convenient to add the plants directly to you by a specimen steamer. If you have plants to distribute, for instance of *Wrightia caput-medusae* or the new rocky mountain plants, mind me, but there is no hurry about it.

I had lately the pleasure of meeting here one of your colleagues, Mr. Elliot, but he was here only a single day.

The western catalogue of Wright's plants is highly welcome, and assists the corrections to some of my hasty determinations. I have now here again the second volume of Richard's Flora from the Yulin library, and shall do my utmost to identify his species, when writing the list of the now-known Sichuan plants. Do you wish to have by and by the definitive names of such numbers as are still blank at the determination of which I have to make a remark? something like

this happening is due to misplacing of numbers, as I have formerly found by comparing Lincky's numbers of Orchids with my own. In looking now over the catalogue, I find for instance no. 2284 = *Angraecum maritime*, while my number 292 (said to be the same) is a new *Thomasia*, called *Th. pulcherrima*.

I have now begun with Euphorbiaceae, and give you as a specimen my determinations. 587 & 1923: two forms of *Succowia multiflora*.
