print, and with the duty it will
be full six weeks before the part
is ready - Gray send me word ~~by~~
what channel the parcel is to be
sent to you - You say & think that I
may send you 12 copies - and I will

put up with them or you desire the
Icones & Statuum for 5 sovereigns, beginning
with the new series (vol xi)

I yesterday posted for you two sheets
of Ge. Ob. - to p. 304 - pro forma corrected
to p. 400. The post will extend to beyond
500 and there will be the bother
of Addenda. We have received 2 new
genera. Nemog of Helleboraceae from
the Sandwich Islands a very distinct
one which on account of some developments
of the upper teeth in the ligulate flower
will be referred to Labiotiflorae but
it is certainly not Malvaceous but
allied to Grindelia though quite
distinct. The other is an opposite-leaved
P. African plant near Peatzie. M' Donn
and Boles are continually sending us

curiosities from C. Africa

I will attend to your direction
about the address a bill for some
