My dear Gray

We have a plant from you
Chaparral Shrub n. 157 marked
Peucephyllum Chaparral A. G. It
is a third species of my Orthocarpus
sect. Catopercia which I am disposed
to raise to the rank of a genus. I
cannot find out whether you have
ever published your Peucephyllum.
If you have I must adopt that
name ~~of course~~ - if never
published I should have taken up mine
of Catopercia but I cannot recollect how
I composed it - I think there was some
misprint about it for as it is it is
nowhere - You will observe that
the stamens are decussate on the
anterior corolla lobe as in Peucephyllum.

not ascending between the two
posterior lobes as in *Agropyrum*.

I write now in a hurry as there
will be just time to get your answer
where if at all you have published
it before the present *Agropyrum*
is now in *Agropyrum* and
Peribacca are in his hand,
I have two sheets to send you
tomorrow
