2 *Pedrus*

3 *Picea* Link. (*Abies* Don)

Anthracium connectivum in appendiculatum is
viz supra loculos prominentes fere glanduliformes
& *Abies* Link. (*Picea* Don including *truga* and
pseudotruga)

5 *Larix*

I want much any observations you
may have to make on *Conifer*.
