Your announcement of intention to devote the
best part of your valuable life to the flora of N.
America pleased me beyond measure
God speed the good work! just think
of it. the best part of half a century ago
I subscribed for that work. still not
completed and the anxiety it has been
to me ever since - the trouble for
away from books of reference until a
part of late - nor even yet the privilege
of consulting verified Herbaria.

In remitting, I was well aware many
things were not ready with you - also
many seeds - but in view of exchange
and for your correspondents abroad
that they would be acceptable - my
disposition or wrong. It's acceptable -
will try and not trouble in these matters
here after.

I doth corrected on the D.Corn quest for
— for myself never thought of accepting such
an idea — but willing to accord my right
to others who do — had to find it was a mistake
of mine.

Will not aware of oversight in sending Corn
unlabeled — perhaps they were wrapped

Unpacking a package. Perhaps they

our Sierras.
