1. *Epidenarum radicans*. 2 *Epid.* very near *E. imatophyllum*
~~but~~ with entire petals. 2u. a variety. 3 *Ep. macrochilum*.
4. *Ep.* a very distinct & interesting addition to *S. Diacrium*.
5. *Oncidium ascendens*. 6 *Camaridium* sp. nov. 7 *Evelyna*
(*aphalophora* Rebb.?). 8 *Evelyna purpuracea* or a very
closely allied plant. 9 ~~Ep.~~ I don't seem to have. 10 *Sarcoglossis*,
perhaps new — but the specimen is a bad one. 11. *Prasavola*
novosa.

- 1 *Pogonia ophioglossoides*, certainly. 2 *Anethusa* sp. n.
quite distinct from *A. bulbosa* in labellum &c. 3. *Calanthe*
discolor. 4 *Crematris* (= *Hyacinthorchis variabilis* Blume).
5. *Oreorchis* sp. n. very interesting. 6 *Epipactis* sp. n.
Cephaelanthus japonica

7. *Aphalanthera* ^{Japan} perhaps new - near *ensifolia* -
 8. *Cochlos latifolia*. 9 *Kadenaria* (rec *Platanthera*) sp. n.
 10. *Platanthera tipuloides*. 11 *Cypripedium japonicum*

Loo Choo Wright.

335. 336. 337 *Spiranthes australis*. 338 *Aceras* - an-
gustifolia aff. 339 *Goodyera procera*. 340 *Microtis*
parviflora !!! What a jump from Australia! 341 *Luscia*
 indeterminate but surely new & account of it
 that oblong fruit. 342 *Liparis repens*.

Bentham says, there were no *Angulone*
Cochlos in the parcel

May you see Wright has got some good
 things. You had made a little paper out of
 this material, with charo. of the new
 species and names.
