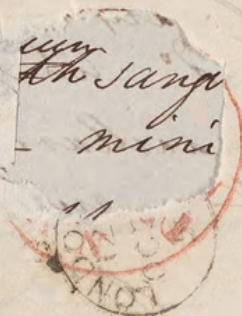

My Dear Dr. Gray
 I am pained how much my attention to the
