C — 2 *macranthus*

I thought Chris had transformed the
proper spec. of *Kunt.* - I neglected
to refer here to the Prov. - sup-
pose it that

C. arvensis W. & A. has the glabrous
corolla and obtuse or hardly acute
leaves.

C. macranthus, i.e. *Spinaea*
macrantha has corolla tomentose
outside, longer acute leaves, & is
the *sp.* *mucosoides*. ROS

the Harkins for a little tour in Normandy,
