at 4,500 ft. Common on sand and
among rocks June

1765 *Phleum alpinum*

Damp hill sides - Head of Tuolumne
river at ^{9,100} 8,800 ft July 3rd -

1842 *Elymus condensatus* -

Common about Mono Lake, and the
dry regions east of the Sierras, 6000-7000 ft.
Generally on rather dry soil, often yellow.
High, from a tough perennial
root, in large bunches - July

Dioecious gray saline soil on the
Islands in Mono Lake,^(6,500 ft) - Deon Seen
common on saline and alkaline
soils at various altitudes - Creeps
by running stems

dry rocks, at Sonora Pass at
about 7000-8000 ft. Not seen much
higher - July 21st.
