rather obtuse.

No. 2 delto,

No. 3, a fragmentary
Parmelia on rocks resembling
some forms of *P. centrifuga*
but not that species. Also
a very little of a *Baellia*
which seemed to be *B.*
stigmatica (Ach.) Koerb. KO -
Thores 12.5 μ x 4 μ , rather sharp.

Red Sea Province. Lander
Jan. 1912,
