

San Francisco March 14th 1874

Gen. E. Savenport Esq.

Dear Sir

Your favor of March 3rd just reached me, and I am pleased to find, that the ferns were welcome and interesting to you. I also received the amount of 7 Dollars remitted, for which I am obliged to you.

The names given in the list enclosed in your letter, seem to differ from those known here and I should like very much to be clear on the subject. Would you be kind enough to send to me by mail one specimen or piece of specimen of each of the following (copied from your list) with names attached, and I will return them again to you with the next mail.

- ✓ " 9 Pellaea ornithopus ✓

- ✓ 16 Asplenium filix foeminae ✓

✓ 17 *Aspidium Novboracense* ✓

✓ 20 *Cystopteris fragilis*. ✓

As for the *Chailanthes*, the specimens sent last
are known as *Ch. Californicum* here, enclosed
I send, what is known to me as *Ch. gracillima*, and
another sp. found in the southern part of California.
Please return them 2 specimens, as I have no more of
them and let me know their resp. names.

I also enclose a frond of *Asplenium ebeneum*
which is a very scarce fern here. Is the name
correct? ² x

I am not a botanist and hardly ever have
time to look up anything, except a matter
of importance. I should like very much to
have a full collection of California dried ferns,
correctly named. At some future time
I may be enabled to send you specimens of
Pleopeltis borealis and other ferns, as you
collect them.
