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Certainly, my dear Doctor that is just the point. Fries certainly named Lepigonum at that place in 1817. What he did afterwards in correcting or changing his opinion does not alter the fact that there he named it as a genus in a way that nobody can mistake, although he failed to name the species under it. Fortunately, however, we are relieved from any more trouble on this score in the Adansonian Tissa!
