I obtained about 60 small ones which I shall put in boxes with *Andromeda floribunda* of which I have got about 2000 from the Cold Mt. for the Messrs. Parsons Enclosed I send you all I could find of the *Buckleya* in flower. I have obtained 12 *Pyrolinae* for you & some few other things. The season is backward & the mountains are now covered with snow. I am very busy in packing I write in haste
