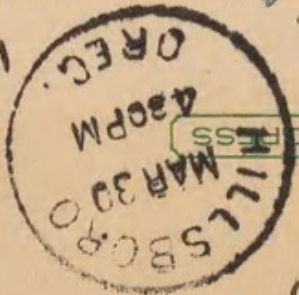
They have just appeared in the ~~Red~~ <sup>Great</sup> Lakes a stream
