My dear Mr. Collins, -

You may put an extra in that
sphagnum-list for *S. recurvum* var.
parvifolium for Vermont, as I have seen
a specimen from the Locality cited in
Grout's list. Otherwise I have nothing
to add to it. Warnstorf's latest treatment
of the European sphagna is in the "Krypto-
gamienflora des Mark Brandenburg"
of which "Leber- und Torfmoos" by C. Warnstorf
constitutes one volume, or a part of one, published
at any rate as a unit, the "Lanemoose"
being not yet complete.

I trust you had a summer of very productive
collecting. I have been here now a little
over two months, and have made two or
three Bryophytic excursions with Hen Karsten.
I suspect you should get some of these
Scandinavian species in your DuRoi
collections. My address after the next
