My dear Dr. Collins,

You may put an ~~extra~~ + in that sphagnum-list for *S. recurvum* var. *parvifolium* for Vermont, as I have seen a specimen from the locality cited in Grout's list. Otherwise I have nothing to add to it. Warnstorff's latest treatment of the European sphagna is in the "Kryptogamen-Flora des Mark Brandenburg" of which "Leber- und Torfmoose" by C. Warnstorff constitutes one volume, or a part of one, published at any rate as a unit, The "Lamsmoos" being not yet complete.

I trust you had a summer of very productive collecting. I have been here now a little over two months, and have made two or three Bryophytic excursions with Herr Kasten. I suspect you should get some of these Scandinavian species in your future collections. My address after next week will be Strgutstr. 20 III, Berlin, W. Germany. With best wishes
