You asked me to send you anything interesting in the Polytrichaceae, and the inclosed are the first two I should like you to examine when perfectly convenient.

Is #807 only a small Polytrichum ohioense? I do not seem to have a good description of this species. The tip cell of lamellae is slightly notched. And can I call #806 a good characteristic form of Polytri-

Chenium communis var. *fungoniale*?
The lamellae in the middle of
the leaf is 7-8 cells high, with
end cell hardly broader than
the rest and only slightly de-
pressed.
