The Ohio hepatics are as follows: 8. *Cephalozia communis* (Dicks.) Lindb.; 19. *Pallavicinia Lyellii* (Hook.) S. F. Gray; 20. *Cephalozia lunulata* Dumort. apparently. The last number is in poor condition and is perhaps mixed with some other *Cephalozia*. I know of no other record for *C. communis* from Ohio.
