Dear Collins.

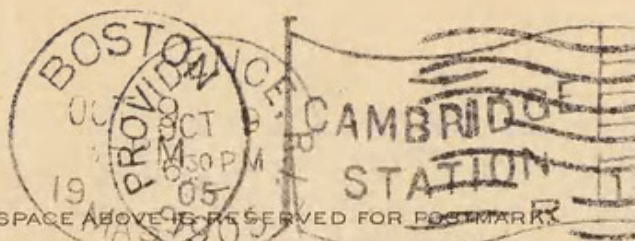
I am sorry to bother you but no. 48 must
