Under Streptanthus carinatus the 4th line ends with oris-  
do you mean cristatis? and is the calyx 5-augusti?

Under Linaria pentaschista 4th & 5th lines æquantibus  
should be æquante

Under Phaseolus macrobotrys 3d line ought not  
infimum to be infimum or is it the poetic genitive?

Under Zephrosia tenella 4th line "infimes x x x"  
bracteatis" don't read right or I have forgot my Latin

Under Indigofera sphaeroarpa 2nd line "petioli"  
should be "petiolo"

Under Petalostemon exile 1st line for "annum" read "annuum"

" Louisia leptocarpa 2nd .. " petioli" read "petiolo"

" Oenothera primiveris 4th .. " longioribus " longiore

" " Chamaenerioides 4th & 5th lines "tubo" x x x

" " longiori is ambiguous and would be better than "tubo calyx"

infundibuliforme lobis subdupo longior ovario multotches buria

Under Lycosperma 9th line for cerohtocae read cerohtocae

" Crucea Wrightii 2nd line "nervis utrinque" <sup>wo</sup> I  
can't translate at all to my satisfaction though it might  
be very plain if I had a specimen to compare with the des-  
cription

7th page 1st line "involute" should be "involuto"

7th ~ 3d " " "vindi" " " "vindis"

" 17th " " biseriali" " " "biserialis"

Under Selinum scapoosa 3d line for "uniserial" and "uniserialis"

" Hymenophyllum Wrightii 1st line "corollis fl. &c" is  
another puzzle and two lines below breviculum  
should be breviculatum

You must have referred to the wrong list for the locality  
of Peganum Mexicanum for it was collected this side  
of the Rio Grande on my return as is evident ~~for~~  
from the fact that I misplaced it in the distribution  
whereas the other collections had been arranged  
by yourself before I went to Cambridge

When is Mr Zuckerman? He has been owing  
me a letter for some weeks

No acute news from Washington yet

A few days ago I received a letter from  
Mr Barthélémy requiring me to deliver or cause to  
be delivered to <sup>him</sup> me all the collections, drawings &c
