Dear Dr. Schlechter:

I have just been working through my Central American species collection of *Polypodiums*. I find a mess, as some of the J. D. Smith numbers of *Turckheimia* plants seem to have been mixtures. The type collection of *P. Polygonates* C. Presl has been mixtures. In the U.S. Natl. Herb. as 7678 of Smith's distribution. In the U.S. Natl. Herb. this number is represented by a specimen that seems to be *P. argyrostictus* Schlecht. In Natl. Herb. Smith's 846? (*Turckheimia* H. 733) is surely *P. Polygonates* C. Presl. As this number *P. Turckheimia* Schlecht. is base. It would help me much to have herbarium of *P. argyrostictus*. *P. stictoplyllum*, *P. Turckheimia*, *P. trilobulatus*, *P. luniferum*, *P. humicola*, *P. Lehmannii*, and *P. magicense*. Can you get these off me very soon? *P. stictoplyllum* in the Natl. Herb. as represented by the number of the type collection seems to be *P. Polygonates*. It would help to have details of *P. Polygonates*. Please!!
