Dear Dr. Kennedy

I enclose two little packets
of moss both collected at
Roaring Brook, Willoughby
St., Aug. 11-'93. I think you
were there at the same time
and perhaps got the same
mosses.

The one with the reddish
lower leaves I suppose to be *Didymodon*
rubellus. The other, with the yellowish
lower leaves, has very similar
leaves, but the fruit is much
longer and I have two or three
fruits with very long subulate
opercula and long twisted teeth.
Can you tell me what it is?

If this blizzard continues
I shall not dare to venture out
tomorrow night, but I hope
the weather will moderate.
