On looking the matter up I find this to be an error of an unbotanical typewriter who copied the article for the "Free Press" of Burlington. The hybrid was *V. fimbriatula* × *septentrionalis*, reported in Rhodora 6: 215, pl. 58. Nov 1904, common in this vicinity.
