Dear Mr. Deane:—

Your post-card of May 13th is at hand.

I was greatly surprised at your finding in the Bull. of the Vt. Bot. Cl. for April 1921 that I had collected the most improbable hybrid, *V. fimbriatula* ^{notice the wrong alphabetical order} x *conspersa* in Middlebury May 23, 1920.

On looking the matter up I find this to be an error of an unbotanical typewriter who copied the article for the "Free Press" of Burlington. The hybrid was *V. fimbriatula* x *septentrionalis*, reported in *Rhodora* 6: 215, pl. 58. Nov. 1904, common in this vicinity.

I hope now to start about the 24 (next Tuesday) for a brief visit to my brother Dr. John, office 419 Boylston St. & shall hope to make a short call on you & Mr. Matthews, & run down to see my daughter Mr. C. A. Adams at Greenwich R. I.
