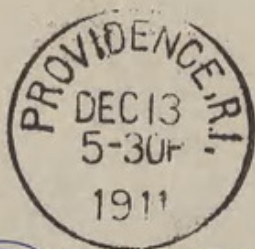


Dear Deane,
