heard from him from Basel -

when I said I had sent via
Barney Bros - London - a venture -
had reached him. He is going
over some of the same ground I
have traversed - I only regret
that we cannot be together. As you
know, he is a good companion
in the field - as elsewhere.

I am glad that the mystery of the
"new bridge" in Rome is solved.

I have cards of various bridges
for you. I have grabbed them
without selection - the fact of its
being a bridge - insured its securing
of the card in any case. I hope
that some of them at least - will
be of interest. There are many cards
issued which make pictures of beauty
of others the same cannot be said.
I have had some very interesting
days here about - Versailles -
Fontainebleau - Marly L. Roi etc -
I get into the forests whenever I can
and am out of doors all that is
possible. Attempting no general
collecting - I get the Pteridophytes
whenever possible - but in the
opportunities so far secured - I
have not found them abundant
either in point of species or
individuals. Most of the forests
are quite innocent of these plants.
