Dear Mr. Deacon:-

I don't think we have yet got to the bottom of the matter of Asplenium pictures. I did not know that you had a blue-print of one of Davy's plants specimens of A. aboreum, var. Hortorum. So, when Mrs. Weatherby found the thing at Somers, Conn., and we brought it home and photographed the living plant, I sent you a copy of the photograph (under the modern name of the plant, A. platyneuron var. incisum). It is that which is lost. You don't need it, having Davy's blue-print; but if you want it, it will give Mrs. Weatherby and me much pleasure to replace it.
