LINCOLN MEMORIAL FROM ACROSS THE POTOMAC, WASHINGTON, D. C.



The Lincoln Memorial, modeled after a classic Greek Temple, is situated on an eminence in Potomac Park on the banks of the Potomac River.

From the far side of Tidal Basin the Memorial as pictured here, mirrored in the placid blue Potomac, is very beautiful and attractive, especially in the early spring when the Japanese cherry trees are in bloom. These trees were a gift of the Municipality of Tokyo to the United States Government when Mr. Yukio Ozaki was mayor of the city.
