I am wondering if I can get you to help me on one of the Alyssums, Alyssum Moellendorffianum of Ascherschön has come into cultivation but I am unable to find a description of it, inasmuch as we do not have the publications in which it was originally described. It is relatively a new species. It comes from Bosnia. You will find a reference to it on page 22 of the first supplement of Index Kewensis. I am enclosing you our page containing Alyssum and you will see that at the bottom of the first column, I have left three lines or so for description of Moellendorffianum. I am wondering whether I could ask you to look up the description and give me enough to fill that space.
