



Body oblong, nayant; with a pair of oppofite membranaceous Wings or expanded proceffes.

SPECIFIC CHARACTER, Sc.

NAKED, OR SHEATHLESS CLIO, with inverfely conical body.

SNAIL-SHAPED CLIO.

LIMACINE OR SLUG-SHAPED CLIO.

NORTHERN CLIO.

The genus Clio, which is far from a numerous one, confifts of animals of a fmall fize, and in general form not ill refembling minute Sepiæ or Cuttle-fifh without arms. This appearance arifes from the body being edged, as it were, with a membrane on each fide, forming a kind of fheath; and on each fide the head is a fmall expanded oval procefs. The fpecies here exhibited is defitute of the fheathlike membrane above-mentioned, and bears no very very diftant refemblance to a fmall flug. Its colour is a very pale or whitifh brown, and its length about an inch and half. It is an inhabitant of the Northern ocean.
