I have no copy of the plates to send you, but perhaps if you have time some day before long, you could drop into the college library and ask to see Champlain's voyages of 1613, preferably the original containing the map, but nearly as good is the Quebec edition of 1870 having the map copied although not very exactly. I would not ask you to take the trouble except that I know that you can give an opinion better than anybody else, and besides it comes right in your line of investigation. I will be much obliged for any opinion about the matter.

We are looking forward here to the appearance of the New Manuel as of course you are. We are holding things in suspense until its appearance.
