

Montreal June 15, 1874

Dear Sir

I have never seen any American specimens of *Milde & Botrychium boreale* and don't know whether any one else has. The authors of the Synopsis Filicum deem it to be a trivial variety of *B. lunaria*. I have Scandinavian specimens but cannot at the moment lay hands on them to see if they include some duplicates. When they do turn up I shall endeavour to bear you in mind. Have you American specimens of the European form of *B. ternatum* commonly called

B. intactolum A. Braun? and from whence? Mr Robinson omits it from his catalogue.

I enclose four specimens of *B. montana* 2 from Lake Sup. and 2 from Lapland. My duplicates are well nigh exhausted but I have some prospects of getting more during the coming season.

I have no *B. ternatum* verum but have *Archonema*.
