

Columbus, May 26 - 1846

Dear Gray - In my hasty note a day or two ago I forgot to return a suggestion you made about throwing the species (in the spirit of Cuvier.) into tribes. — This cannot be done now — The tribes of Miffs are not yet sufficiently agreed upon — Even the genera of many of our Miffs are not properly worked out. — For instance no two of our Adelorean *Pterigynandrus* belong to the same genus — many other similar cases —
