My dear Gray —

I have just rec'd  
yours of 22<sup>d</sup> and with some part of  
your text — with suggestions that I  
will think over — no especially  
about the genera, there should  
have been 12—15 more  
but I will make lists of them —  
I would prefer to have the Myrs &  
Araliacæ plots begin at I and end  
at VIII. — I may some day add  
a parcel of more plots for American  
Species that have not been fig'd and  
say about 4 to the plate which I would  
now think a luxurious amplitude of  
space. I rec'd the prof'g of the 1<sup>st</sup>

plate and returned it some days  
since - The Engraving is up to the  
mark -

I send by express (which I  
consider safer than the mail) today  
Plate VII, and if it is not too late -  
and can be neatly <sup>done</sup> I want one of the  
genera "Grimoldia" put in the place  
of "Stictzia" on Plate VI, and Stictzia  
take the place of Grimoldia on Pl. VII -  
in other words let the two genera  
change places - This brings all the  
Marchantiace together as they should be.

Proof of 2<sup>d</sup> Plate not yet received -  
I shall want some 70-100 copies  
of the Mott. struck off on very nice  
paper & bound, with regular paging,  
title page & index and perhaps a prefatory

note or so - of all this before  
VIII & last plate under way - will  
be finished in 7 or 8 days -

Text of Hepaticae ready for the  
printer - a good deal of Miss  
text printer -

Working very hard - hardly  
take time to smoke a cigar!
