Dear Gray -

The Explorations of the plates
 with proofs of *Hypocrea* were sent
 long ago. - I did not return
 the Proofs of the Plates, as I wrote
 that all that was required was
 to see that the names of the
 genera were correctly engraved
 for which the plate-proofs were
 not necessary. -

I now return *Murici* up to p.
 60. with several corrections
 in red ink which see. -

Under *Dichelyma falcatum*
 I have given a new habitat
 If it can be put in there, well.

if not. make a sort of an addition
to the additions, thus, "Mr Frost finds
near Brattleborough Vermont, *Dechelyna*
falcatum and the true *Hypnum*
polaris Linn." — I have said under
Hypnum 1030 that *H. polaris* L. had
not been found within our limits,
which was true as far as I knew
at that time, but a day or two since
^{Frost} sent me it and ^{D. falcatum} — *H.*
polaris can't be introduced any
where except in the additions.

I send you what I have to
say by way of prefatory remark —
my idea is to have no caption
such as "Preface &c" —

Will send the index as
soon as I get the remaining

proofs that is — in a day or two after.

Have the 250 copies well and
neatly bound — I will want
75 to 100 copies. — Have me six
copies bound each with an al-
ternate blank leaf of good and
rather closely ruled writing paper
through the whole, and the fly
leaves of the same kind of paper.

The parcel containing *Flora*
Javanica &c was received, and
as bad luck would have it, just
there published my new *Diphyysium*
found in Venezuela by Goudot — I had
just had made by Schrad. a very
nice drawing of it for Lilliermans or some
other German! —

Better let me
see the explanations
before final printing
