Dear Sir

My esteemed friend Prof.
Henry informs me that I have com-
mitted an impropriety in having forwarded
my account directly to yourself, as Chair-
man of the Library Committee, instead of
addressing it to Capt. Wilkes, the agent
of the Committee. I beg to assure
you that I was not aware of the improprie-
ty and am very desirous to correct it, now
that it is kindly pointed out. For this
purpose I wish to withdraw said account
dated March 20th 1852, as also a former

bill for \$365. (included in the above) and rendered
by me in June 1851; and I hereby authorize
Prof. Henry to receive the same for me.

Dear Sir

I present to you, herewith,
for your examination and approval, my account

I am informed that I have committed an
official impropriety in having forwarded these

Committee, instead of to yourself as the agent of the
Committee for passing such accounts and transacting
other business relative to the Exploring Expedition.

I desire at once to apologize for this inadvertence, which was purely accidental, and arose from my having at the time occasion to write to Mr. Pearce; for I had no wish to have my accounts presented and audited in other than the usual ~~form~~ mode.
