

very shiny; principal internodes much abbreviated, mostly 1.5 cm. long or less; nodes not annulate; leaves decussate-opposite, 1-foliolate, numerous, rarely binary; petioles rather heavy, short, 10--15 mm. long, glabrous, shiny, swollen at the apex and base, articulate at the apex; leaf-blades coriaceous, uniformly dark-green on both surfaces, lanceolate, 3--13 cm. long, 1.1--4.8 cm. wide, smooth and very shiny on both surfaces, acute or short-acuminate at the apex, entire, subacute at the base; midrib slender, slightly prominent above, sharply prominent beneath; secondaries slender, about 10 per side, arcuate-ascending, mostly flat above, very slightly prominulous beneath, arcuately joined near the margins beneath; veinlet reticulation invisible above, mostly obscure beneath; inflorescence apparently racemose and axillary and perhaps also terminal and subpaniculate, rather few-fruited, apparently simple, 5--15 cm. long, the peduncle and rachis glabrous and shiny; fruiting-pedicels heavy, about 5 mm. long, glabrous; fruiting-calyx cupuliform, to 7 mm. long and 15 mm. wide, heavy, glabrate, the rim entire or subentire.

The type of this species was collected by Jean Baptiste Louis Pierre (no. 37) -- in whose honor it is named -- in the Dinh mountains at Baria, southern Cochinchina, Indochina, in March, 1867, and is deposited in the Britton Herbarium, from the Krukkoff Herbarium, at the New York Botanical Garden. The collector names the common Annamese name "com tao" or "kum tao" and says that the corolla is blue. Dop identified it as Vitex holophylla Baker.

xVERBENA GONZALEZI Moldenke, nom. nov.

VERBENA BRACTEATA Lag. & Rodr.

Demaree states that "old stems will get covered up by sand and dozens of new branches will come up." Whitehouse 16263 was taken from a plant so large that three full herbarium sheets were made from it. E. J. Hill 269.1889 in the University of Illinois herbarium has the spikes especially densely flowered. The erect form of the species is well exemplified by Clokey 8096 from Nevada and by Ownbey & Weber 2746a and by J. H. Christ 12973 from Idaho. Ownbey & Weber 2746b is the typical prostrate form. Ewan 11418 has its leaves extra finely cut. The physico-chemical properties of the sap in relation to phytogeography are discussed by Harris (1934) on the basis of specimens collected

(1) in a broad wash through sagebrush community west of Grantsville, near the old Wrathall ranch, Stansbury Mountains, Tooele Valley, Utah, (2) from drifting sand or sand-ridges on the second terrace of the Sevier River, Utah, beyond the bridge on the Lynndyl-Oak City road, and (3) from the drift zone of the sandy beach of Utah Lake, near Provo Beach, west of Provo, Utah.

Verbena bracteata has been found by collectors in a tremendous variety of habitats, including along roadsides and roadside ditches, on gravelly banks and sand ridges, in sandy pastures, river bottoms, and scattered pinewoods, along the borders of lakes, the edges and bottoms of dried-up ponds, on sandy roadside banks and sandy sagebrush slopes, in alleys and parking strips, on plains and prairies, dry sunny or low prairies and dry meadows, on dredged land at the edges of ponds, on sandy river-banks and sagebrush flats, on grassy flats of Bouteloua gracilis, in orchards, meadows, farmyards, and dooryards, on dry rocky riverbanks and river bluffs, on gravel- and sand-bars, among grass in parks, open grasslands, on arid plains, clay prairies, and clay ridges, in gypsum and the muck of lake-beds, on damp sandy-gravel flats, ditch-banks, and deserts, in the cinder beds along railroad tracks, on the banks of sloughs, in sandy sagebrush deserts, on sand or saline flats, gravelly or sagebrush hillsides, and gravelly prairies, in moist meadows and low moist or open places, on buttes and high plains, in the desert adjacent to cultivation, in blackland prairies and near or along irrigation ditches, on seaport ballast, in alluvial flat waste places, on sandy clay-loam bottoms, at the margins of epsom lakes, in bare clay areas on hilltops, in dry gravel or loam near rivers, on limestone slopes, in dry xeric outcrops and domes of the Viola Lime formation, and on brushy flats. It has been found growing in clay, red clay, and sandy clay soil, heavy or rocky soil, sun-baked clay adobe, earthy soil of limestone areas, loose gravelly or dry gravelly soil, sandy, dry sandy, dry sandy sunny, and even very dry sandy soil, as well as in damp or low moist or dry rocky soil, hard dry or adobe soil, in granitic, igneous, or dry grassy waste soil, and even pure sand. It is often found in sandy soil in sunny places, damp soil by streams, and moist soil along lake-shores. It is most common in waste places and open places generally, along sidewalks, and in railroad ballast. I have personally seen it in very dry windswept places at the seaward side of the lighthouse at Montauk Point, Long Island. Collectors describe it from dryish or sandy canyon floors, sandy level terraces, yellow pine forests, sandy lake-margins, and rocky pastures, from wharves and railroad sidings, lumberyards, dry rocky places, clay soil in prairies, fields about ponds and the edges of fields, dry slough bottoms, dry or sandy riverbanks, and streets, fields in the juniper belt, vacant pastures and lots, semi-cultivated fields, dry knolls, sandstone mesas, sand hills, gravel bluffy and grassy roads, in very dry hills, silty soil in valleys, the dry sand of lake-margins, borders of thickets, alkali flats, moist spots of flat prairies, Sarcobatus flats, sandy plains and riverbottoms, rocky hillsides and dry clay slopes, sandhills and

creek bottoms, along ditches on level prairies, and at the edges of runoffs. It is said to inhabit dry mesas and dry grassy bunch-grass land, sandy, open sandy, and low sandy ground, dry ground and dry hard or dry open ground, dry sterile or nearly cleared ground, low ground, and ballast ground. It seems to like gravelly mesas and dry gravel hills, gravel shoulders of highways, dry lakebeds, sandy alluvium and sandy, sandy loam, or open roadsides, dry rocky or sandy ridges, low waste places and grassy situations, clearings, dry sandy prairies that are exposed to the wind, graded roadsides in pine forests, steep prairie-covered loess bluffs, muddy ditch-banks in prairie soil, dry crevices and ledges of Sioux Quartzite, sandy dry banks, and weedy roadsides. It is commonly met along watercourses and lakeshores, near ponds, on ledges and drying banks, in sandy or bare clay areas, and in the open sod of dry prairies. It has been found growing well in rich or moist black loam, as well as in sandy, alluvial sandy, or clay loam. It has been collected at altitudes of 100 to 9000 feet, flowering and fruiting continuously from April to October.

Gates states that it inhabits "dry places along roads and on prairie and plains" throughout Kansas, and that it is a therophyte or hemicryptophyte; Mackenzie found it common in sandy soil in Wyandotte County of that state; Hancin says "common in waste places". In Alabama Earle (1902) reports it as only "occasional, roadsides and waste places". Pammel says it is common as a weed along roadsides and in pastures, associated with *V. stricta* Vent., *V. hastata* L., *Juncus tenuis* Willd., and *Persicaria mitis* Gilib. In Iowa Tolstead reports it from sandy soil mixed with cinders and gravel, exposed to full sunlight in well-drained land. Welch asserts that in Indiana it is "common" in Jasper County, while Grimes reports it as growing along with *Diodia teres* Walt. along railroad rights-of-way in Putnam County. "Large mats are common" in Siskiyou County, California, according to Cooke, while Moffatt says it is "abundant in old pastures" in Du Page County, Illinois. In Arizona Hanson found it "common and abundant in waste places", Whiting describes it as a "weed in wash bottoms", and Heller found "prostrate plants forming mats in low ground." Grassl found it "common near base of ridges", Cutler "common in dry fields", and Marcelline "common in yards and gardens" in New Mexico. Voss encountered it "occasional in hard-packed roadsides in Michigan". Nobs and Smith discovered it with *Cressa*, *Sida*, and *Frankenia* on dry mud flats in California. Head says that it is scarce in rich soil of dry lakebeds in Jeff Davis County, Texas. St. John says that it is "common in dry places, persisting as a weed in dry farming regions in upper Sonoran and arid Transition zones" in Washington.

It is found "along streets and in open waste places" in Washington County, Arkansas, according to Harvey; "abundant in dry sandy fields" in Fairfield County, Connecticut, according to Eames; "in dry clearings of conifer woods on hillsides" in Keweenaw County, Michigan, according to Hermann; and as a "weed in cinders along railroad tracks" in Sussex County, New Jersey, ac-

cording to Clausen & Edwards. In the state of Washington Smith found it "below highwater line along the river" in Grant County, while Dana collected it in the bottom of a coulee and scattered on prairies in Franklin County. Scoggan says that in Manitoba he found it on "saline prairie and dried middle river channel", while Dodge found it "plentiful" at Point Edward, Ontario, where many other botanists have also encountered it as a weed. Blankinship describes it as a "roadside weed" in Gallatin County, Montana, and Flint comments that it inhabits "little-used roadbeds in gravelly disintegrated granite, with no forage value" in Jefferson County. In Kentucky it is "a prostrate tough weed of door- and barnyards", according to Shacklette. Benson lists it as a denizen of the Lower and Upper Sonoran and Transition life-zones. Fogg encountered it as a "weed along sidewalks" in Philadelphia County, Pennsylvania. In Utah it is described as a "weed in yards" by Maguire & Becraft (Millard County) and "local in somewhat moist sandy bottoms" (Juab County) or "common in the streets of Kanab" by Tidestrom (Kane County), "in sand with Artemisia tridentata" by Keck (Millard County), "common along roadsides" by Pammel & Blackwood (Salt Lake County), "frequent in open spots in dry soil" by Cutler (Juab County), while Gould says "in heavy black soil of drying banks of vernal pools". In California's Merced County it grows on dry mudflats with Cressa, Frankenia, and Sida, and in salt sloughs with Chenopodium and Gnaphalium. In Waukesha County, Wisconsin, Pohl encountered it as "common and low in schoolyards with Eragrostis, Poa, Matricaria, and Melilotus". In Iowa, according to Pammel, it is "common in waste places, roadsides, walks, gravelly and sandy fields; abundant...on gravel on knolls with V. stricta and Baptisia leucophaea and in cultivated ground." Fawcett reports it as "common in sandy prairies and waste places.....Mississippi Valley from Florida and Alabama to Minnesota, British Columbia and Arizona." Jones avers that it is an inhabitant of the Lower Temperate life-zone in Lincoln County, Nevada, while Holmgren reports it "frequent as a roadside weed in dry gravelly soil," and Clokey collected it in a "field in juniper belt" and "roadsides in Larrea belt" in the same state, but Allen reports it "not common" in Lyon County.

In Idaho, Sandberg, MacDougal, & Heller say it is "frequent on rocky hillsides"; Schallert says it is "common in deserts" of Arizona. It grows on "dry banks of treeless creeks" in Oregon, according to Lawrence, in "dry fallow ground, especially along run-off rain washes" and "fairly common in dry sand" in Boulder County, Colorado, according to Ewan, and "infrequent in moist pastures, in sandy loam soil" in Grant County, New Mexico, according to Maguire, Richards, & Moeller. Waterfall found it in openings in pine forests on shale hillsides in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, and on rolling plains among numerous clumps of Yucca in Cimarron County, Oklahoma. The Degeners found it on gravel on an open Juniperus plateau in Colorado.

Miss Perry, in her excellent monograph of the North American members of this genus (1933), gives the distribution of V. brac-

teata as "Waste places, Maine to Florida, west to California and northern Mexico". She also remarks that this is "A readily recognized and widely distributed species varying greatly in habit and pubescence as well as in length and position of floral bracts. The typical form is a sprawling hirsute plant with laxly ascending branches and spreading bracts. In New Mexico it appears as a nearly erect herb (V. imbricata Woot. & Standl.) with shorter and ascending or appressed bracts (var. brevibracteata Gray). Some phases of this variation occur throughout the northwest range of the species, but since these tendencies to vary are apparently lacking in correlation, they do not seem worthy of nomenclatorial attention." R. J. Ferris 9770 is supposed to represent the var. brevibracteata type well, although it was distributed at V. robusta Greene.

Hegi (1927) says of its occurrence in Germany "1864 von Stocker eingeschleppt bei der Baumwollspinnerei Feldkirch gefunden" and also remarks that it is useful in the treatment of scrofula.

Palmer (1935) describes the habitat of V. bracteata as "fields, roadsides, and waste ground. Circumneutral. General". It is probable that the species is native from Michigan, Ohio, and Tennessee westward to the Pacific Coast and south to Texas and northern Mexico, and has been introduced locally in portions of Canada from Ontario to British Columbia and along the eastern and Gulf seabord from Maine to Florida and Louisiana. Renner says that it is grazed from June to October in New Mexico.

The "Swanson" County, Oklahoma, recorded for this species by me in my Résumé 26 (1959) appears to be an error. There is no such county in Oklahoma, nor can I locate a town by that name in the state. The "Riverside" County, Colorado, recorded on page 24 of the same work appears to be an error for Riverside County, California, and the "Alturas" County, Idaho, on the same page seems to be an error for the town of Alturas in Modoc County, California.

The Arsène s.n. in the Berlin herbarium bears a label reading "Pl. du Mexique", but there is also an inscription reading "vicinity of Santa Fé", so I am assuming that the plant was actually collected near Santa Fé in what is now the state of New Mexico, U. S. A.; likewise a similar sheet in the Britton Herbarium at the New York Botanical Garden is inscribed "Las Vegas", which I assume refers to Las Vegas, New Mexico (not Nevada). The Howell s.n. from "Cascades" and the Gorman s.n. from "Lower Cascades", Oregon, cited hereinafter from Hood River County, might as well have been collected in Wasco County. H. H. Rusby s.n. [Oak Creek, May 30, 1883] may have come from either Coconino or Yavapai Counties, Arizona; Edw. Palmer 1048 may well have actually been collected in Nuevo León, Mexico. Whitehouse 8739 may have come from Santa Fe County, New Mexico — its indefinite label reads merely "Las Vegas -- Santa Fe"; similarly, Tharp 6274 and 6284 could have come from either Lamb or Lubbock County, as their

labels read merely "Lubbock -- Littlefield", Texas; Tweedy 3365 may have been collected in either Johnson or Sheridan County, Wyoming -- its label reads "between Sheridan and Buffalo"; W. H. Rhoades s.n., cited below from Van Buren County, Michigan, could have originated in Kalamazoo County, since its label says "between Papaw and Kalamazoo". The Fremont s.n. collection cited below was marked "Mexico" by Mrs. Palmyra Mitchell at the New York Botanical Garden, on what basis I do not know. Parish 8490 bears a printed label reading "Plants of Southern California", but in longhand is stated "Bottomlands of the Colorado River, Ft. Yuma", so I assume that it came from what is now Yuma County, Arizona. Parish & Parish 2171 was collected at San Bernardino, California, in 1891 -- in 1914 a note was added by one of the collectors "this station is destroyed and I no longer find the species at San Bernardino."

The A. S. Hitchcock s.n. [McPherson, July 1892], cited below, is cited in the Flora Kansana as "V. hastata x bracteosa", while the s.n. [Wabaunsee Co., Aug. 23, 1896] is there cited as V. canadensis. Over s.n. [July 14, 1914], Cutter 33, and Smith & Rinehart 82 are mixtures with V. bipinnatifida Nutt.; Oyster s.n. [July 1885] is a mixture with something boraginaceous, while Bethel s.n. [1910] in the herbarium of the California Academy of Sciences is mixed with a species of Lycopus; Arsène 1885 in the Pomona College herbarium is a mixture with V. plicata Greene, and Burk s.n. [Girard Point] is a mixture with V. canadensis (L.) Britton. G. D. Fuller 10186 in the herbarium of the Illinois State Museum, distributed as V. bracteata, is actually Veronica arvensis L. in the Scrophulariaceae; Loomis 3133, distributed as this species, is Monarda mollis L.; C. Wright 1545, at least insofar as the Columbia University Herbarium specimen is concerned, is not verbenaceous; Earle s.n. [Auburn, 16 May 1896], distributed as Verbena bracteata, is Phryma leptostachya L. in the Phrymaceae. Wallis 4944-1 is a mixture with V. bipinnatifida. J. Lauber 101 [4483], distributed as V. bracteosa, is actually V. ciliata Benth., Edw. Palmer 342 is V. lasiostachys var. septentrionalis Moldenke, J. B. Davy 16 is V. quadrangulata Heller, and Lapham s.n. [M. Spear, 1858] is xV. perriana Moldenke.

In spite of the extremely distinctive characters of Verbena bracteata, material of this species has been misidentified and distributed in herbaria as V. ambrosifolia Rydb., V. aubletia L., V. bipinnatifida Nutt., V. canadensis (L.) Britton, V. canescens H.B.K., V. canescens var. neo-mexicana A. Gray, V. caroliniana Gmel., V. ciliata Benth., V. gracilis Desf., V. hastata L., "V. hastata var.", V. hastata x bracteosa Gates, V. menthaefolia Benth., V. plicata Greene, V. prostrata R. Br., V. pumila Rydb., V. robusta Greene, V. spuria L., V. wrightii A. Gray, Lippia cuneifolia Steud., and even Gentiana bracteosa Greene!

As is to be expected in the case of a species with such a wide distribution, the list of popular names is rather long, including "bracteated vervain", "bracted verbena", "bracted vervain", "hoary vervain", "large bracted vervain", "large-bracted vervain", "large-bracted vervaine", "large bracted vervane", "large-leaved vervain", "lavender ground-flower", "long-bracted vervain", "mat verbena", "prostrate vervain", "small verbena", "spreading vervain", "verbean vervain", "verbena", "vervain", "verveine", and "vervian". It should be noted, however, that the name "hoary vervain" is more properly applied to V. stricta Vent., while "verveine" is applied also to the genus Verbena as a whole as well as to V. bonariensis L., xV. hybrida Voss, V. officinalis L., Phyla nodiflora (L.) Greene, and Stachytarpheta jamaicensis (L.) Greene, and "verbena" is applied to the genus Verbena as a whole, as well as to V. bonariensis L., V. corymbosa Ruiz & Pav., V. hastata L., xV. hybrida Voss, V. litoralis H.B.K., V. officinalis L., V. peruviana (L.) Britton, V. platensis Spreng., V. stricta Vent., V. urticifolia L., Bouchea prismatica (L.) Kuntze and its var. longirostra Grenz., Clerodendrum fragrans var. pleniflorum Schau., Priva lappulacea (L.) Pers., Stachytarpheta calderonii Moldenke, S. cayennensis (L. C. Rich.) Vahl, S. frantzii Polak., S. guatemalensis Moldenke, and S. jamaicensis (L.) Vahl.

Our species is mentioned by Wyman & Harris (1941) under the form-genus name "?aze-(č'il) biláta do.' izigi", and is said to be used by the Navajos to stop postpartem hemorrhage. Seymour (1929) records the following fungi as infesting it: Aecidium verbenae Auct. Amer., A. verbenicola Ell. & Kellerm., Dicaeoma verbenicola Arth., Puccinia sydowiana Diet., P. verbenicola Arth., Erysiphe cichoracearum DC., and Septoria verbenae Rob. It was introduced into cultivation in 1801 or earlier, and Bailey (1935) lists Cronamere as offering it to the horticultural trade. The "8743" cited in Univ. Calif. Publ. Bot. 24: 198 & 274 (1951) is probably a misprint for Clokey 8473.

MacDougal (1907) suggests that what he calls V. bracteosa Michx. (now more correctly known as V. bracteata Lag. & Rodr.) may hybridize in the wild with V. canadensis (L.) Britton, with V. hastata L., and with what he calls V. angustifolia Michx. (now more correctly known as V. simplex Lehm.). However, he cites no specimens, gives no descriptions of the supposed hybrids, and does not say that he actually ever saw any such hybrid plants. I doubt very much whether these species hybridize and certainly have never yet seen any such hybrids myself. The only hybrids which I recognize are xV. bingenensis Moldenke [V. bracteata Lag. & Rodr. x V. lasiostachys var. septentrionalis Moldenke], xV. deamii Moldenke [V. bracteata Lag. & Rodr. x V. stricta Vent.], and xV. perriana Moldenke [V. bracteata Lag. & Rodr. x V. urticifolia L.].

A. H. Smith (1868) records V. bracteata as "rare" at Kaign's Point, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Jones (1941) records it from Ross County, Ohio, on the basis of a Bartley & Pontius collection. Lowe (1943) says it is occasional on prairies and waste ground at Elgin, Lena, Lyleton, and Ninga, Manitoba -- I have not yet seen material from the first two of these localities. Jepson (1943) records it from Kern County, California; Braun (1943) from Mc Creary County, Kentucky; Harper (1924) from Scioto County, Ohio; Clausen (1939) from Camden County, New Jersey; Monachino (1960) from Bronx County, New York; Porter, Woodward, Pride, & Howard (1940) from Worcester County, Massachusetts; Deam, Yuncker, & Friesner (1950) from Marion County, Indiana; and Ogden, Steinmetz, & Hyland (1948) from Cumberland and Penobscot Counties, Maine; while Palmer (1916) cites his no. 454 from Jasper County, Missouri. Schauer (1847) cited a Schrader collection from Illinois, as well as non-localized Michaux and Douglas collections; Farwell (1938) records it from Houghton and Wayne Counties, Michigan, and says "The Keweenaw stations extend the range of this species much farther north than it is generally recorded". Muenscher says that it is "Native from Ohio westward and southward; locally introduced in the northeastern states and on the Pacific coast." Groh (1944) says that in Canada it is an annual, found in sod and waste places in dry land. He cites the following material not as yet seen by me: ONTARIO: Lambton Co.: Groh s.n. [Pt. Edward, 1924]. [Lethbridge, 1914]; Groh s.n. [Lethbridge, 1929]. North Battleford Co.: Carmichael 75. "Cavendish": Campbell 44. BRITISH COLUMBIA: Cariboo Co.: Fletcher s.n. [Lake Kamloops, May 29, 1885]. Yale Co.: Eastham s.n. [Osoyoos, 1938]; Groh 243. He notes that the Point Edward "infestation" dates back to 1889, at least, since the species was found there by Dearness, according to Macoun's Catalogue. David Macoun also collected it "near the forks of the Red Deer and Saskatchewan rivers, Aug. 8, 1879."

Douglas H. Kent, in a letter to me dated November 28, 1949, says that the species is adventive in England. Thurston & Vigurs (1922) cite a Harvey collection from Bodmin Road Station, Cornwall, collected in 1918. Gay (1849) says "En la quinta noticia de las plantas raras del jardin botánico de Ginebra, A. de Candolle indica esta especie como propria igualmente de Chile, lo que es muy dudoso." I have not as yet seen any material of it from Chile, wild or cultivated.



This form differs from the typical form of the species in having white corollas.

The type of the form was collected by Theodore Dru Alison Cockerell on the campus of the University of Colorado at Boulder, Boulder County, Colorado, on July 15, 1908. It is said to inhabit bottomlands, and has been collected in anthesis in July and August. Even though Cockerell published the original name for this taxon as a trinomial, in the manner of zoologic subspecies, he followed it with the expression "n. var.", indicating that a varietal status was intended. The only recorded common name is "white-flowered large-bracted vervain". Three herbarium specimens have been examined.

Erect, robust or coarse, perennial herb, to 3.1 m. tall, often suffrutescent or woody at the base, erect; stems rigid, wiry, stout, erect, often numerous, several from the base, very acutely tetragonal, often much branched, eventually constricted or slightly subarticulate at the nodes, green, smooth, glabrous throughout or practically glabrous below and somewhat scabrous-pubescent above, the upper parts often naked, the angles sometimes prominent and white; rhizome creeping; middle stem internodes 5--20 cm. long; branches ascending or divergent-ascending, their upper parts naked; leaves varying from sessile or subsessile to short-petiolate, the petiole (if regarded as such) 0.3--1 cm. long and broadly winged; lower and middle leaf-blades oblong or elliptic to oblong-lanceolate or lanceolate, 3--19 cm. long, 1--2.3 cm. wide, shortly acute at the apex, somewhat convex along the margins, shortly and cuneately attenuate at the base and prolonged into the petiole, rather rigid, green on both surfaces, scabridous or strigillose and somewhat pustulate above with impressed venation, sparsely pubescent beneath, penninerved, more or less crenate-dentate along the margins to sharply serrate or incised, at least above the middle, the teeth 0.5--1 mm. long and 1--2 mm. apart or the uppermost 1--2 mm. long and 3--6 mm. apart; upper leaf-blades greatly narrowed, lanceolate to linear-elliptic or linear, to 1.5 cm. long and 3--5 mm. wide, entire or subentire, more or less subrevolute along the margins; secondaries 4 or 5 per side, more or less prominulous beneath, eventually impressed above, subparallel on the upper leaves; spikes cylindric and compact during anthesis, mostly short and strict, slender, 1--8 cm. long (rarely to 14 cm. long), densely congested and densely flowered toward the apex, not uniformly loose, 4--5 mm. wide, sometimes with the lower flowers more loosely scattered, terminately pedunculate, fastigiately paniculate toward the apex of the branches, usually sessile in open cymes, not crowded, eventually elongating; bractlets ovate-lanceolate or lanceolate to lanceolate-setaceous, about 3 mm. long, scarcely as long as or longer than the calyx or subequaling the flowers, subulate at the apex, ciliate, appressed-puberulent on the back or strigose-pubescent especially along the margins; flower-buds purplish-brown; flowers small; calyx ovate-campanulate, 2.5--3.5 (or more) mm. long, its tube 2--2.5 mm. long, somewhat shortly appressed- or strigose-pubescent on the outside (especially on the ribs), the teeth 5, short, lanceolate, usually about 0.5 mm. long, acute, the short subulate tips connivent after anthesis; corolla small or minute, varying from blue, deep-blue, dark-blue, clear-blue, blue-violet, or blue-lilac to purplish-blue, lavender-blue, lavender, purplish, pale-lilac, lilac, pale-purple, or purple, sometimes violet, pale-violet, white-violet, pinkish, pink, or red, occasionally lavender with a pale center, slightly surpassing the calyx, its tube darker, finally exserted 0.5--0.8 mm. from the calyx, short-puberulent or pubescent outside, the limb inconspicuous, about 2.5 mm. wide, the lobes 5, small, subequal, emarginate, barbulate-pubescent at the throat; pistil and the 5 stamens scarcely or not at all surpassing the corolla-

mouth, usually included; cocci oblong or oblong-linear, yellowish-brown or brown, 1.5--2 mm. long, shorter than the calyx, the dorsal surface strongly striate with 5 longitudinal ribs, raised-reticulate at the apex, the entire inner face minutely papillate, with the commissural surface plane and minutely scaberulous; chromosome number: $n = 14$, $2n = 28$.

The type of this species was collected by José Mariano da Conceicao Velloso at or near Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, and is no longer available for examination, and this fact has contributed to the considerable confusion regarding the true identity of the species. Briquet proposed several species to take care of what appear to be forms of one and the same taxon, although more study is needed here to dispel all doubts. The type of his V. approximata was collected by Benedict Balansa (no. 1027c) at Assomption, Paraguay, on January 5, 1875; the type of his V. cordobensis was collected by Paul Günther Lorentz (no. 131) at Estancia Germania, Córdoba, Argentina, between June and December, 1874; and the type of V. boliviensis was gathered by Gilbert Mandon (no. 524) in Bolivia. The type of V. littoralis f. angustifolia was collected by Emil Hassler (no. 3853) in a swamp near Tucangua, Paraguay, in February, and is deposited in the Delessert Herbarium at the Conservatoire et Jardin Botaniques at Geneva, as are also the types of the other names referred to above. V. bonariensis var. veris is based on Teodoro Rojas 1045 from near San Bernardino, Paraguay, collected in February, 1915, and deposited in the herbarium of the Museo de Historia Natural at Montevideo.

The V. cordobensis form of the species is characterized by greatly elongate spikes, and is well represented by Morong 128 from Paraguay and by Ruiz Leal 8398 from Argentina. The short-spiked more typical form of the species is well represented by Barros Valenzuela 8045 from Chile and by a whole series of Argentinian specimens, including Cuezzo 1290 and 2210, Luna Risso 935, and Villafañe 794, 917, and 970. The type of V. officinalis var. gracibras Lehm. is Jørgensen 3767 from Paraguay, deposited in the Dudley Herbarium at Stanford University.

Verbena brasiliensis, as interpreted by me, is a widespread species, native from Colombia and Brazil south through Peru, Bolivia, Paraguay, and Uruguay to Chile and Argentina, but widely introduced and naturalized in the United States from Virginia to Florida and along the Gulf coast to Texas, as well as in Oregon and California, Jamaica, South Africa, and Madagascar. It is cultivated in Brazil, Uruguay, Belgium, and Maryland, having been introduced into cultivation in 1904. It may be distinguished from V. bonariensis by its leaves being cuneate-attenuate to the sessile or subpetiolate base, not cordate nor amplexicaul as in V. bonariensis. Cabrera & Dawson (1944) call it a hemicryptophyte frequent in wet soil in Bolivia, Paraguay, Uruguay, and northern Argentina. Kuhlmann & Kühn (1947) refer to it as a nomophyte.

Schauer (1851) divides his V. litoralis H.B.K. into two varieties [he calls them "forma"]. The first of these, α pycnostachya, he characterizes as "spicis virgineis densioribus subcylindricis" and to it he brings the V. litoralis H.B.K., V. brasiliensis Vell., V. bonariensis β litoralis Hook., and V. glabrata H.B.K. as synonyms. His second variety, β leptostachya, he characterizes as "spicis jam virgineis magis filiformibus, dein saepius valde elongatis et relaxatis" and to it he brings V. caracasana H.B.K. and V. lanceolata Willd. as synonyms. He notes "Forma umbrosa, plerumque magis glabrata, spicis pube appressa subcanescentibus. Varietates ceryis limitibus haud circumscribendae crebis modificationibus intermediis invincem transeuntes." He says also "Utraque forma vulgaris in campis Brasiliae meridionalis, e. gr. in prov. Sebastianopolitana circa urbem; Harrison, Gardner, Lhotsky, Sellow, Ackermann, Mart. (Herb. Fl. Bras. n. 1033), Guillemin, Vauthier (n. 192), Lund; in prov. Minarum: Riedel, Raben, Regnell (n. 326). Forma α etiam provenit in Bonaria, Chile, Peruvia, Columbia, Venezuela: -- forma β in Mexico, Venezuela, Guiana." I regard V. litoralis, V. brasiliensis, and V. glabrata, as well as V. bonariensis, as separate species, albeit often with what appear to be intermediate forms (which may represent natural hybrids).

Concerning his V. approximata Briquet says: "Cette espèce est très voisine du V. litoralis et n'est pas facile à en distinguer quand les feuilles inférieures manquent. Le V. litoralis possède des feuilles inférieures moins oblongues, grossièrement et irrégulièrement incisées-dentées, tandis qu'elles sont régulièrement et finement crénelées-dentées dans le V. approximata. En outre, ce dernier a des tiges à angles plus aigus, presque subailes grâce au sillonnement des faces, et des feuilles inférieures plus allongées étroitement linéaires, plus raides. L'inflorescence et les caractères floraux sont tout à faire ceux du V. litoralis var. brasiliensis." Concerning his V. cordobensis he says: "Cette espèce est rapportée par Grisebach dans l'exsiccata cité au V. ephedroides Cham. Mais ce dernier type, spécial au Brésil méridional et à l'Uruguay, en diffère abondamment par ses feuilles toutes réduites à de petits phyllomes linéaires très courts ou à des écailles, ses tiges bien moins robustes, à angles moins tranchants et moins saillants, à rameaux fastigies, ramassés, ses épis très courts densiflores, ses calices oblongs dépassant sensiblement les bractées. Le V. cordobensis est plus voisin des V. littoralis et V. Isabellaei pas l'ensemble de son organisation; c'est cependant, dans ce dernier groupe, l'espèce qui se rapproche le plus des Junciformes."

Collectors state that V. brasiliensis is found along ditches, roadsides, and waysides, railroad tracks and low pastures, disturbed soil, between sugarcane fields, in and near cultivated ground, in wet uncultivated ground and fields, marshy and swampy

places, on ballast dumps and ballast ground, riverbanks, levees, and open rocky hillsides, in moist spots along watercourses and irrigation ditches, the edges of fields, in shallow pools on prairies, in shady places, pinelands, flax fields, roadside swales, marshes, fields, swampy meadows, irrigated fields, swampy lowlands, dry sandy or waste ground, swamps, rocky fields, and coastal prairies, in open woods or open places in woods, campos, batture, vacant lots and waste places in general, moist valley land and coastal areas, the sandy clay of road embankments, limestone soil at the edge of montes, black soil, open hillsides, and even subparamos. It is perhaps most characteristic of wet places. In Brazil it has been collected from sea-level to 900 m. altitude, in Arkansas at 300 feet, in California from 80 to 700 feet, in South Africa from 4200 to 5500 feet, in Bolivia from 6500 to 12,000 feet, in Chile from 200 to 1200 meters, in Argentina from 460 to 1620 meters, in Mexico from 1000 to 2000 meters, in Peru from 1000 to 3700 meters, and in Colombia from 1700 to 3250 meters. It has been collected in anthesis during every month of the year, and in fruit from April to December and in February. In the United States it blooms throughout the year, but mostly from April to September.

In Louisiana Ewan describes it as "common in grassy places" and "a tall rank weed along battures", while Ashbey says it is "frequent in cane fields" and "frequent in drainage ditches" and that it occurs mixed with Ambrina ambrosioides in sugarcane fields and along ditch banks. Demaree avers that it is "very common all along the coast in Mississippi. In Texas it was found by Gould in partial shade along roads through pine forests, while in California it is common in large clumps along roadsides in Yuba County according to Raven, is locally common in low ground in Butte County according to Howell, is found on ditch banks in irrigated pasture areas in San Joaquin County according to Cramp-ton and occurs in light-colored clay-like soil on roadcut slopes in Eldorado County according to the same collector, who also refers to it as a "weed in vacant lots" in Sacramento County. Howell reports it as a "roadside weed" in Stanislaus County. This collector's no. 30055, by the way, is said to be from the type region of V. hansenii Greene. Feddema says that the species is common in wet meadows in loam soil exposed to the sun in Nayarit and in grasslands with occasional shrubs on moist clay loam in open sun in Michoacán.

In the Transvaal it occurs in mountainous areas with many springs and streams, some wooded and some grassy areas, on basically dolomites and limestone covered with deep humus in many places, according to Rodin.

Collectors in South Carolina report it there from waste ground, roadsides, railroad yards and rights-of-way, warehouse areas, creek bottom woods, fields, swamp forests and forest margins, and in sandy marl along waterways. In Alabama it has been found along roadsides and on old Amerind shell mounds. Kral & Redfearn say that it is "rare on wet sandy-peat of pondshores" in Florida. In

North Carolina collectors have found it along railroads and at railway stations, in waste places, about homesites, along roadsides, and on savannas.

The G. L. Fisher 48132 at Göteborg, cited below, is definitely *V. brasiliensis*!

Perry states that this is "A species very similar in habit to *V. litoralis*, but readily distinguished by the differences in inflorescence. The spikes of *V. brasiliensis* are short, compact, sessile, and regularly arranged in open cymes, whereas those of *V. litoralis* are longer, compact or somewhat elongate, peduncled, and arranged in more or less paniculate cymes."

Common names recorded for *V. brasiliensis* include "Brazilian vervain", "camaradinha", "erva de pae caetano", "formosa sem dote", "herba do pae caetano", "jurupeba", "oi", "quininha", and "verbena". The last-mentioned, however, is applied also to the genus as a whole, as well as to *V. bonariensis* L., *V. bracteata* Lag. & Rodr., *V. corymbosa* Ruiz & Pav., *V. hastata* L., *xV. hybrida* Voss, *V. litoralis* H.B.K., *V. officinalis* L., *V. peruviana* (L.) Britton, *V. platensis* Spreng., *V. stricta* Vent., *V. urticifolia* L., *Bouchea prismatica* (L.) Kuntze and its var. *longirostra* Grenz., *Clerodendrum fragrans* var. *pleniflorum* Schau., *Priva lappulacea* (L.) Pers., *Stachytarpheta calderonii* Moldenke, *S. cayennensis* (L. C. Rich.) Vahl, *S. frantzii* Polak., *S. guatemalensis* Moldenke, and *S. jamaicensis* (L.) Vahl.

Sampaio & Peckolt (1943) reduce *V. brasiliensis* to synonymy under *V. litoralis*, as do also Hooker & Jackson in the "Index Kewensis" (1895), while Schauer (1847) reduces it to a mere variety of *V. litoralis*. The two species are, however, reasonably distinct. The following brief key will help to distinguish *V. brasiliensis* from its immediate relatives:

1. Leaves sessile, clasping at the base.
2. Leaves small, 2--4.5 cm. long, 3--8 mm. wide, subcoriaceous, serrate at the apex only or entire; pubescence on rachis, bractlets, and calyx glandulose.....*V. intermedia*.
- 2a. Leaves large, 5--10 cm. long, 5--22 mm. wide, coarsely serrate from base to apex, membranous; pubescence on rachis, bractlets, and calyx not glandulose.....*V. bonariensis*.
- la. Leaves distinctly petiolate or cuneately attenuate to a subpetiolar base.
3. Inflorescence lax, elongate; flowers distant; pubescence on rachis, bractlets, and calyx very minute and closely appressed.....*V. litoralis*.
- 3a. Inflorescence dense, contracted; flowers mostly closely congested; pubescence on rachis, bractlets, and calyx spreading.....*V. brasiliensis*.

Glaziou (1911) calls his no. 14162 "*Verbena littoralis* H.B.K." and 14162a "*V. intermedia* Gill. & Hook.", but the former of these numbers is herein cited as *V. brasiliensis*. Villafafle describes

the flowers on his no. 970 as "amarilla", but this must surely be an error. The printed label for the Congdon s.n. [Sept. 2nd 1903] collection cited below is inscribed "Plants of Mariposa Co.", but Bouldin Island is located at the mouth of the San Joaquin River in San Joaquin County, California. Killip & Garcia on the label of their no. 33849 report that the species is used in the treatment of typhoid fever in Colombia, but this collection looks very strange -- it is very leafy, like some forms of V. glabrata H.B.K., yet its inflorescences are very pubescent. Hammarlund 631 has much of the aspect of V. parvula Hayek and may prove to be that species. Tate 206, from an altitude of 12,000 feet at Pongo, Bolivia, may prove to be V. hispida Ruiz & Pav. The Sprague s.n. specimen in the Kew herbarium is anomalous and may actually prove to represent V. litoralis var. caracasana (H.B.K.) Briq. Lutz 1185 is a mixture with V. litoralis, while Worth & Morrison 16498 is a mixture with V. bonariensis L.

Glaziou (1911) identifies his no. 356 as V. bonariensis, but it is actually V. brasiliensis. Specimens of this species have also been misidentified and distributed in herbaria as V. angustifolia Michx., V. bonariensis L., V. bonariensis var. brevibracteata Kuntze, V. bonariensis var. longibracteata Kuntze, V. ephedroides Cham., V. hastata L., V. hispida Ruiz & Pav., V. intermedia Gill. & Hook., V. isabellei Briq., V. litoralis H.B.K., V. litoralis Kunth, V. litoralis var. caracasana Briq., V. litoralis var. caracasana (H.B.K.) Briq., V. litoralis var. caracasana Kunth, V. littoralis H.B.K., V. officinalis L., V. officinalis var. graciliscesns Kuntze, V. polystachya H.B.K., V. stricta Vent., V. venosa Gill. & Hook., and even Verbesina occidentalis Walt. On the other hand, the Hassler 7064, distributed as V. approximata, and the Hassler 6685, distributed as V. litoralis var. brasiliensis Briq., are both V. montevidensis Spreng.

Demaree states that "a large field develops in less than 5 years" in Arkansas; Ahles, in Alabama, found the species very abundant along railroad tracks and on dry savannas. In Mississippi Demaree found it "very common all along the coast", while Bailey calls it "a common weed" in Louisiana. In Texas it grows abundantly in black soil according to Warnock. Smyth affirms that in Peru it is the "common tall verbena of the valley, common along railroad tracks and between cane fields." In Minas Gerais, Brazil, it is said by Irwin to be found "in red clay soil, common especially in waste places"; Lutz found it "abundant" in Rio de Janeiro, and Bailey refers to it as a "weed" in the same state. According to Rosengurtt it is "common in swamps and fields" in Uruguay. Hunziker refers to it as "rare" at La Villa, Salta, and Pedersen says that it is "not common on wet sandy soil" in Corrientes, Argentina. Miss Mexia reports it as "common and widespread in hedge-rows and cultivated fields" in Minas Gerais. In Chile, Elliot

says it is "eaten by cattle". Bryant tells us that in the Cape of Good Hope it is a "large regular but open growing bush 3 feet high and several feet in circumference." Fasciation is seen on Barros Valenzuela 8002 in the Britton Herbarium at New York. The Sprague s.n., cited hereinafter as from Meta, Colombia, may well have been collected in Cundinamarca -- its label merely states "between Villavicencio and Bogotá". The surname of the collector, Freyreiss, is misspelled "Freyreis" on some Stockholm sheets.

Illustrative of the difficulty of identification attending some specimens of this species is Rojas 1045 -- this specimen was originally named V. bonariensis by the collector; then as V. bonariensis var. brevibracteata by Hassler; then as V. litoralis by Osten, and finally as V. bonariensis var. veris, also by Hassler. Sanzin 274 was identified as V. litoralis by Hauman, Rojas 1887 as "V. litoralis Kunth vel affinis" by E. Almquist, and Herb. Osten 18497 as "V. litoralis Kth. ad V. bonariensem L. spectans" by Osten.

It is of interest to note that Small (1933) recorded the species from only Louisiana; Fernald (1950) extended the range in the United States from "Fla. to La. and n. to se. Va.", while in 1952 I further extended it to include Arkansas and southern California. This is apparently an index to the rate with which it is spreading in the United States.

Briquet (1904) cites Hassler 1027b and 1027d from Paraguay and Regnelli A.475 1/2, A.3647, and A.3651 from Brazil. Fernald (1938) records the species from Warwick County, Virginia, while Kuhlmann & Kühn (1947) cite M. Kuhlmann 66 from São Paulo, Brazil. Ahles, Bell, & Radford (1958) cite Bell 2520 from Beaufort County, South Carolina.

Perry (1933) cites the following 28 additional specimens not as yet seen by me: NORTH CAROLINA: New Hanover Co.: Randolph 1004 (G); J. K. Small 5707 (E, G). GEORGIA: Chatham Co.: Kolthoff s.n. LOUISIANA: Plaquemines Par.: Lloyd & Tracy 20 (E, F, G, W). By error she cites the Louisiana specimens under Alabama. What she cites as "Small 5707" seems to be Herb. Biltmore 5707, at least in the Britton Herbarium at New York, as well as in the University of North Carolina Herbarium.

In all, I have examined 513 herbarium specimens, including the type collections of many of the names involved, and 4 mounted photographs.
