Durieu cherubimys the following:

Boerhaavia muricata, Urbium Boott

(*I. Ceylanensis* same locality)

I. macrospora Catskill Mts (same as
my *Echoloba*? Stark Durieu has seen)

I. Bravaisii, my whipsaw plant

I. melanopoda E. Hall's Athens 'Ill. in' plant

The latter I have growing - I suspect it a
depauperate plant stunted by the drought -
we shall see this year.

Bravaisii I take for *Echinospora*
macrospora perhaps = *laevigata*
muricata perhaps = *riparia*
and possibly *riparia* and *Ceylanensis*
identical. But let the Botanists
fight it out.

Wright 1460 is *Morina punctata* Griseb as I find
from DC. Prodr. - Why not *M. sericea*? -

I find in my herb *M. Torranea* n. sp. from Chapman,
Stark is, it seems, his *M. inodora* Boott. - This is
not in DC. & nor do I find there two Cape species
M. serrata and *M. laevigata*. Although he knows Chapman's
work

I mention this - but I do not want to give
you any trouble with it.

M. laevigata Boott, or something like it
I have from Stark from mouth of Mississippi -
but it seems to be also *M. sericea*. Broad-
leaved forms are *laevigata*, narrow-leaved ones
have same teeth and are more like the
ordinary *sericea*.
