elaborated species


Another character - which however is
too minute to be adopted - a flower
is the size of Pollen, which in A. minima
is much larger in Oxyodri smaller
than in any other species - time of
flowering which - variation must be
early spring - in all other late summer,
and other minor characters.

I suspect it is monocarpic!
growing 3 years.


I enclose 3 seeds

how to send such things from here.


I believe also that the number and arrangement of bundles of vessels in the stem will furnish characters.




Oxycedris

28th I just got a letter from E Hall. He says he has plants for sale, which Wright is to distribute, and among them are Arentholium or Abies grandis something unknown to me - either a new species or a new name of an old species.

I should be much obliged to Wright if he would send me all Isoetes, Arentholium and Cat-ti-trace at once, to be returned. I shall want a set of Hall's plants, besides clearing out if possible the common ones.

I shall send the Yucca seeds
with Hooker's together, as
soon as I hear from you
