Here is still another Helenium from Arizona, which appears to be new. It is near to A. Mexicana, though sufficiently distinct by its twice larger flowers, shrubby habit and leaves in pairs rather than verticals. But I dare not trust to Dr. Gray's description alone for my assurance that it is not his A. Schaffneri. It is far indeed from answering thento, but I wish a comparison to be made, and, in Dr. Gray's absence, upon
