done pretty well *Lamprothamnus*  
in the *L. dentatus*: but bears  
of flowers all quite diff'rent & the  
plant a mass of the deepest blue  
flowers. *Nicotiana acuminata*  
is a good species a family figured  
in Bot. Reg. This has been  
a trying winter to numerous  
tender plants in our gardens.  
*Catunia chrysophylla* is quite  
unharmed. I don't think *Velutina*  
*longituba* specifically generically  
distinct from ~~*Velutina*~~. There  
never seen however good flowers  
of the former, a work to be done.
